- Which areas of my life need some attention?

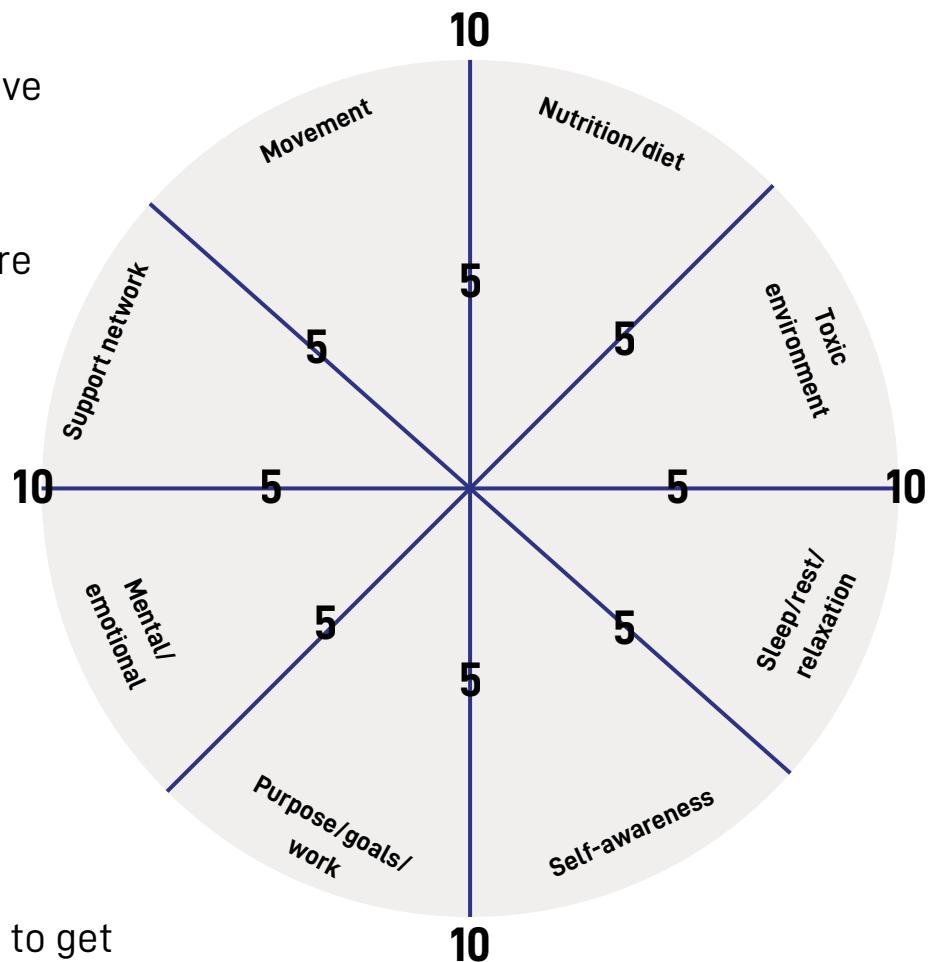
What number would you give to each area currently?

- What would I need to do to make that happen?



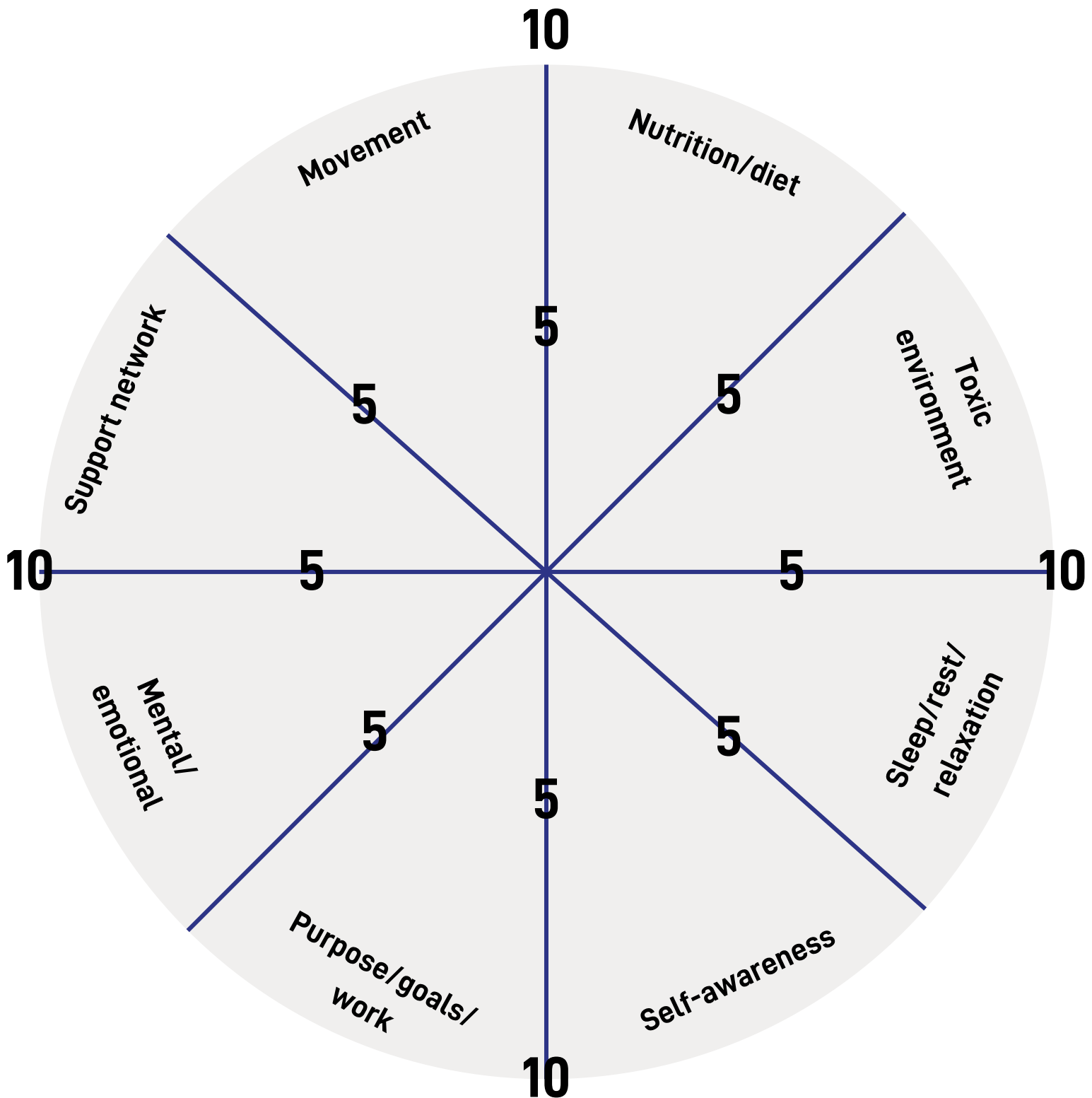
Even small, incremental changes can make a substantial difference in achieving a more balanced and fulfilling life.
